SCHUMANN Extends Management

From 1st January 2025 Prof. Schumann GmbH will have a further Managing Director, Dr. Adam Melski. The Management Board will continue to be led by Dr. Martina Städtler-Schumann as Chairwoman. We now want to change this and to unite all of the themes relating to software development under one person", explained Dr. Martina Städtler-Schumann. She remains the Chairwoman of the Management Board and in future will be responsible for all areas relating to personnel. Evgeny Kulyushin will now concentrate on marketing and sales and Jan-Torben Schwager will be responsible for central administration and compliance tasks. "With Dr. Adam Melski we

are very pleased to have found a colleague who has both extensive leadership experience and a history of involvement in large IT projects, and we are convinced that SCHUMANN will profit from these changes", said Kulyushin.
